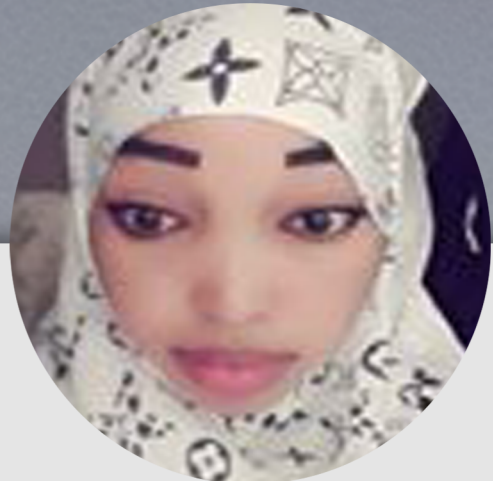

Abstract

Assessment of Immunization Coverage on Measles among <5 Years Children at Xawaadle, July 2014, Hargeisa, Somaliland.

Suhaib, Abdul-Qadir, Ahmed, Asma & Mohamed.

According to UNICEF (2008) report the under-5 years mortality rate in Somaliland is 145/1000 live birth. The children are the most vulnerable segment of the population, but many of the ailments that cause death in this population can be avoided by completion of routine childhood vaccination. Thus in our research we aimed to assess the immunization coverage on measles among <5years children at Xawaadle July 2014, Hargeisa Somaliland. Additionally the purpose of our research was to contribute the understanding of socio-demographic factors influencing child and maternal immunization at Xawaadle community. So, we used quantitative type of research and questionnaire as data collection tool. More ever, our research design was descriptive cross sectional survey. After we concluded our research period we gain result of 44.3% of target population were immunized, while 50% of them didn't get immunization care, with 5% of them in unknown category, in education manner of our research the mothers we assessed 23% of them were educated, and the rest were ignorant people. In immunization aspect 6.7% of our studied mothers have knowledge on NIS, unlike this percent most of these mothers were aware that vaccination is good for health as well, it can prevent some diseases. In summary, we recommended in order to achieve the Millennium Development Goal (MDG), we have to continue the steps that contribute to stride forward, this included raising up mothers general knowledge specially those related health objectives like NIS, also it is so crucial to do recurrent immunization awareness.

ABSTRACT

Factors Influence People to Purchase Antibiotic Medicine without Prescription in Sh.Nour village, Hargeisa Somaliland

The purpose of this study was to examine the factors influence people to purchase antibiotic medicine without prescription, which is normally purchase prescription letter only to treat severe bacterial infections. The misuse of antibiotics have resulted in rapidly increasing levels of bacterial resistant to antibiotics, leading to a loss of antibiotic value that can be seen all over the world in the form of failed medical treatments and prolonged infections. The point prevalence of Bacterial Resistance ranges globally in 3% to 75%. In the study, the research design and approach was descriptive cross-sectional and quantitative respectively. The participants of this study were 93 respondents selected randomly from 1200 households. The instrument of this study was investigator-administered questionnaire and sample of antibiotic medicine tablets to show the respondents how they understand the asked questions. Moreover, to strengthen the study, different previous researches and published related literatures were carefully reviewed. The finding of this study shows prevalence of antibiotic consumption among Sh.Nour village whether doctor prescribe or not was very high in 94%. Similarly, self-medication level was sky-scraped that is 89% of the respondents involved self-medication practice in last three months prior the data collection, which made worse by many factors including limited numbers of health clinics among Sh.Nour village, high consultation cost, attitude of the community and easy availability of antibiotic medicines. Similarly this study identified that the community purchase antibiotics and use irrationally and unnecessary situations, which losing the medical importance of antibiotic medicine. Likewise community have no knowledge to use this important and harmful medicine, although more than half (54%) of respondents were state that they have a knowledge. Consequently the community purchases antibiotic medicine with improper symptoms and absent of prescription letter, which is not rational usage of antibiotics. This malpractice is resulted the poly-pharmacy which made available antibiotic medicine without prescription, although illegal. Therefore, based on the finding of the study, it recommended executing awareness to the community for rational usage of antibiotics and its harmful effects and situating plans and regulations to restrict antibiotic purchasing without prescription and propagate to pharmacist and/or pharmacy staffs.
