





ABSTRACT

Knowledge, Attitude and Practice on Female Genital Mutilation among Women in Reproductive Age at Digaale Internally Displaced People Camp. Hargeisa, Somaliland. June 2015

Abdimajid, Nasra, Anisa & Laila.

FGM is referred as Female Genital Circumcision or Female Genital Cutting and it constitutes all female Procedures that involve external genitalia of the female. Historically this procedure of FGM goes back to centuries ago. In 2001, 100-140 million girls and women were subjected to one of several forms of genital mutilation. Most of these girls were living in African Countries, since of them were also living in Middle East Countries. It was also subjected millions of girls of immigrant population in Europe, United States & Canada. In Somaliland FGM Procedures is done in anywhere of the country. FGM in Somaliland has long been accepted that is a ubiquitous in Somaliland Institutions concerning the family health. This procedure is commonly performed in girls of age 4 and 7, & this 95-100% in 1999. Since there efforts to eradicate this procedure, now the prevalence is somehow decreased. Our general objective was to determine the Knowledge, Attitude & Practice on FGM among women in reproductive age at Digaale IDP camp, Hargeisa Somaliland on June 2015. The research design that we used in our research of KAP on FGM among women in reproductive age was a cross-sectional study design, both approaches of quantitative & qualitative (Mixed Approach). We did a survey, and used simple questionnaire, for assessing the level of knowledge, attitude & practice of women in reproductive age on FGM. The main outcomes of our research of KAP on FGM was that the knowledge of our target population was so low, since the community have no enough knowledge about FGM, they were believing that FGM is a good procedure. 74.3% told that they don't have any more Idea about FGM and can't explain it, while they believe that it's good procedure. Finally our study got that the community's knowledge and attitude is low and we recommended that It's mandatory to increase the level of knowledge & attitude to decrease the practice on FGM of the women in reproductive age. A lot of efforts must be done, the government, international NGOs & community elders should work together and take steps on increasing the knowledge & attitude of the community on FGM.

ABSTRACT

The Prevalence of Self Medication without Prescription and Factors Influencing Self-Medication at Jigjigayar Village, in Hargeisa, Somaliland. July 2015

The purpose of this study was to inspect the prevalence of self medication without prescription which is increasing day after day and linked to the treatment of major and minor health conditions however, the self-medication has potential risk include: incorrect self-diagnosis, delays in seeking medical advice when needed, incorrect manner of administration, incorrect dosage, incorrect choice of therapy, and risk of dependence and abuse of drugs and eventually leading prolonged infections. Studies showed that the increase in self-medication was due to a number of factors like socioeconomic factors, ready access to drugs, the increased potential to manage certain illnesses through self-care, and greater availability of medicinal products, educational level, age and gender are the other important factors influencing self-medication. One of the most common reasons for indulging in self-medication includes high cost of private doctor's consultations; the point prevalence of self medication globally is 75%. The scope of the study was Jigjigayar village Hargeisa, Somaliland. In the study the research design and approach was descriptive cross-sectional and quantitative questioner. A total of 151 subjects from 2000 households were selected by random sampling with pretested interviews schedule, information regarding self-medication use in the past three months and associated with socio demographic factors, thus different previous researchers and published related literatures were also reviewed the findings of this study shows prevalence of self medication among Jigjigayar village was very high in 70% because many factors exacerbated the situation of self medication including limited number of health clinics among Jigjigayar village similarly community has no knowledge to differentiate the importance of medicinal drugs and harmful of self medication, this malpractice is resulted the pharmacies to sell the drugs without prescription because there is no clear policy made by the MoH to restrict the availability of medicine without prescription. Therefore, based on the result of the study it is recommended that all pharmacies mustn't sell medicinal drugs without prescriptions promulgate the community to go health centers including hospitals and health clinics and take prescription letter from professional doctors.
