ABSTRACT

Knowledge and Practice of Mothers Towards ANC in SH. Omar Village. Hargeisa, Somaliland

Hamse , Roda, N. Ibrahim, Adam, Hamda, N. Mohamed, Sahra, Hodan

The objective of this study was to assess the knowledge and practice of mothers living in this village. The only MCH in SH. Omar confirmed that ANC visits of mothers in the village are far more less than expected. This is what stimulated the researchers of this study to investigate the knowledge and practice of ANC among mothers in this village. In the study cross sectional study design was conducted among 186 mothers in the village in June and July 2016. The participants were interviewed using questionnaire and obtained data was analyzed using SPSS package, version 12.0. The research found that 52.7% of the mothers thought that they had no need to go to ANC check-up during their pregnancy, and majority of them, being 66.3%, did not understand that high blood pressure affects the fetus growth. It was more than expected to find that 56% of the mothers participated in this study, did not practice ANC regularly during their pregnancies. The research concluded that majority of mothers in SH. Omar village had poor knowledge and practice about ANC and its utilization services to make the matter worse, their educational level was far below average also. Based on the findings and conclusion of this research, the study recommends for ministry of health, health NGOs, MCH in the village, to make a campaign of awareness towards ANC importance among mothers in the village. The study also recommends to make health education and health promotion among mothers in the village in order to enhance their level of knowledge and practice towards ANC.

ABSTRACT

Socio-cultural and Health Related factors that Contribute high incidence of Tuberculosis in Hargeisa Tuberculosis hospital patients

The purpose of this study was to examine the factor that contribute high incidence of tuberculosis in Hargeisa TB hospital patients. Tuberculosis (TB) remains an important public health problem throughout the world. There are a lot of people who developed TB especially low socio-economic ones. The general objectives of this study were to investigate social, cultural and health related factors that contributes high incidence of tuberculosis in Hargeisa TB hospital patients. To expand the capacity of this research both primary data which was 80 questionnaires consisting 29 questions and secondary date which were used published books, internet and other important sources were used. The research design and approach was descriptive cross-sectional and quantitative respectively. The participants of this study were 80 respondents selected randomly from 220 patients. The time scope of this study was June to July 2016. This study showed that majority of the respondents 69% were met social stigma from the community and they take phobia for their disease. The conclusion of this study showed that, majority of the patients 64% were living in overcrowded place with non-ventilated areas, so this may increase the incidence of the TB. Also this study highlighted that majority of the respondents were said that the TB hospital was far apart from their home. This problem can lead the patients not to go to the hospital. This study recommends to build health facility specially Tuberculosis hospitals in the major areas of the country. More over not stigmatize patients who have Tuberculosis positive because stigma can cause the patients not to arrive at the hospitals and hide their problem.


